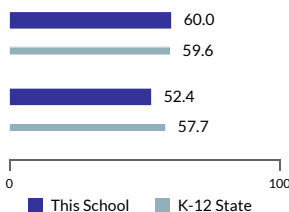

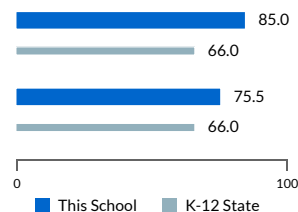

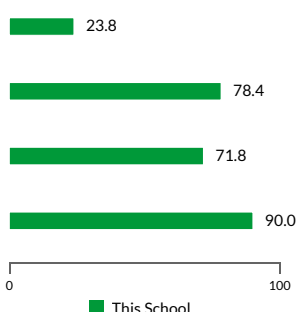

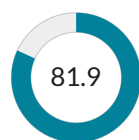

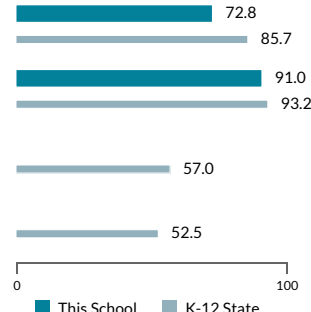


#### ON-TRACK TO GRADUATION

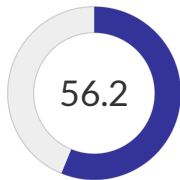




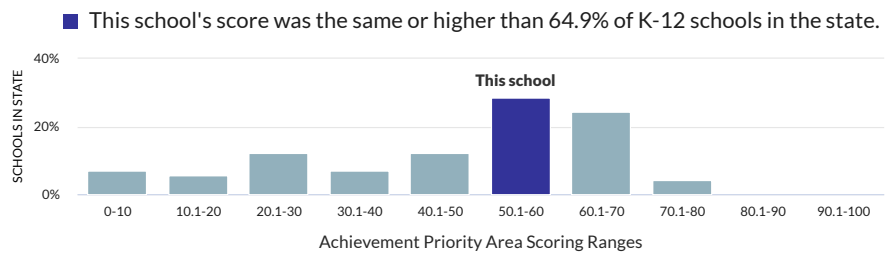
## ACHIEVEMENT

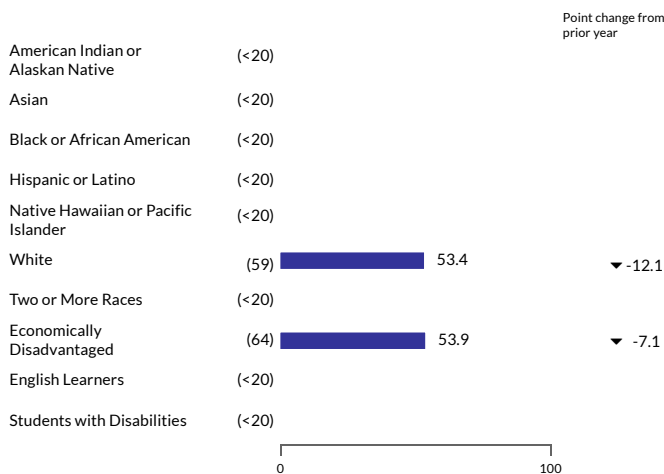

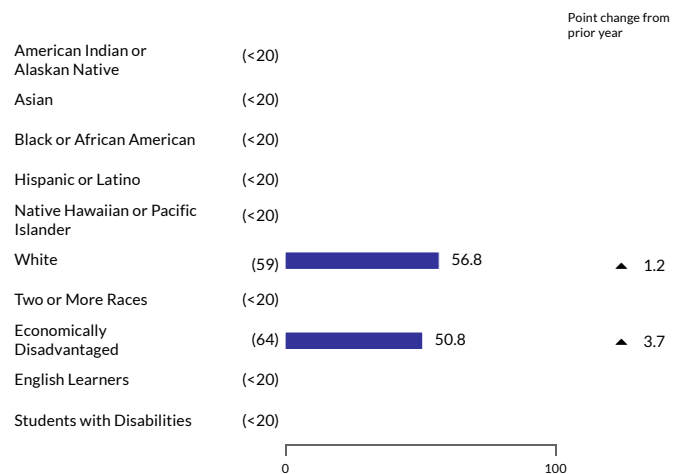

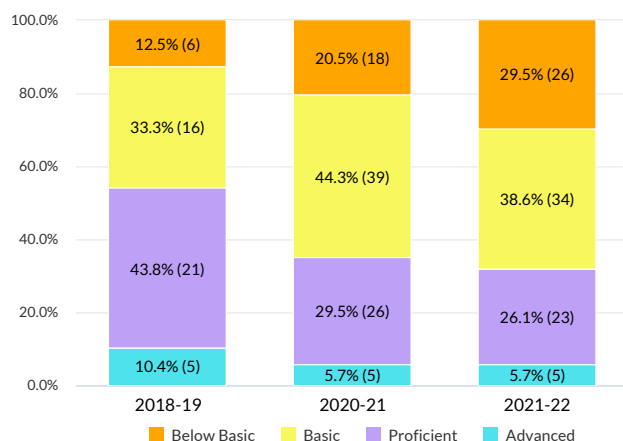

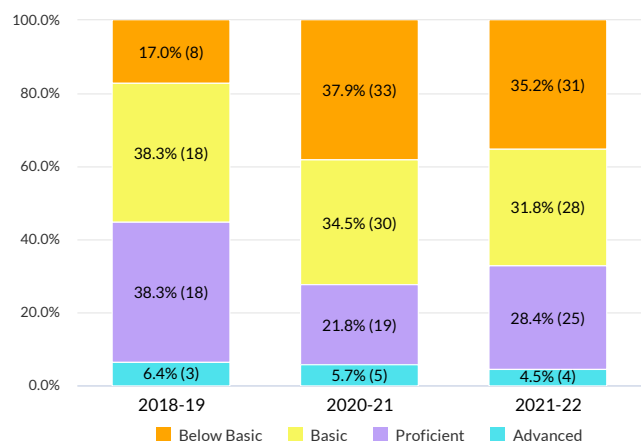

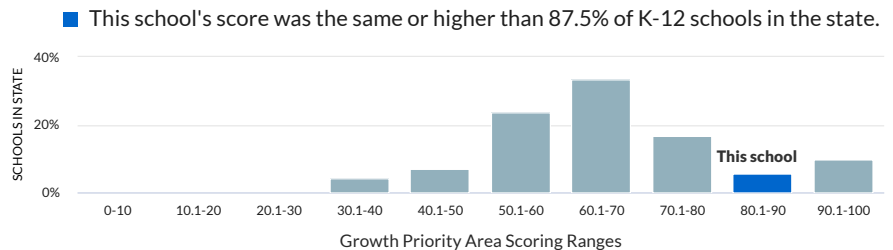
## GROWTH

This priority area measures year-to-year student progress on statewide tests. It uses a value-added model that seeks to control for circumstances beyond the influence of educators. A high value-added score means that on average students in the school are progressing more quickly than other, similar students. Growth is scored from 0 to 100 to match the other priority areas and is a conversion from the roughly 0 to 6 value-added score.

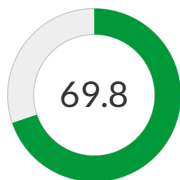

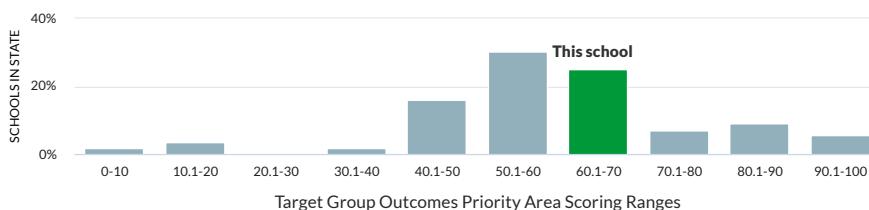
## TARGET GROUP OUTCOMES

This priority area examines outcomes for students with the lowest test scores — the Target Group. It is designed to promote equity by helping schools focus on learners who need the most support while also improving outcomes for all students. ■ This school's score was the same or higher than 78.6% of K-12 schools in the state.



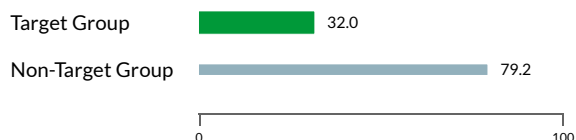

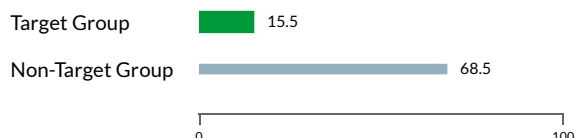

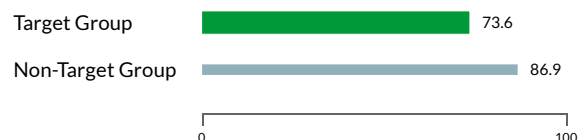

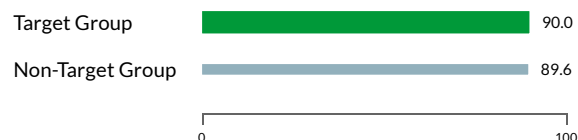

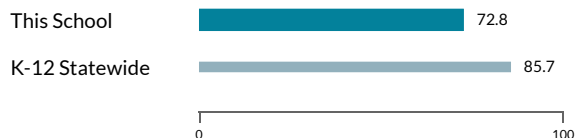

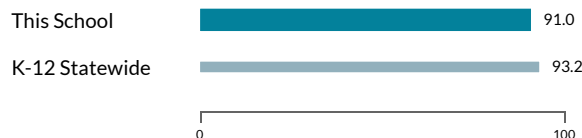
